

## 6 Day Intercessory Prayer Guide

*“He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.” – Colossians 1:13-14*

Scripture tells us that believers’ prayers are “powerful and effective” (James 5:16). This plan will guide you through Scripture-based prayers for your friends & Family members who haven’t yet trusted in Jesus. Use it to call out to God, asking Him to transfer them from “the dominion of darkness” into “the Kingdom of the Son he loves” and to enable you to point them toward Him.

### Day 1: John 3:16

*“For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.”*

Lord, you love \_\_\_\_\_ more than I can even understand. Thank you for sending your Son so they can be saved. Please help them realize how much you love them, and give them faith to believe in Jesus and receive salvation (Eph. 2:8-9). Move in their heart to embrace your free gift of eternal life.

### Day 2: Matthew 11:27b

*“...no one knows the Father except the Son and those to whom the Son chooses to reveal Him.”*

Jesus, please reveal yourself to \_\_\_\_\_, so they may know the Father. Please expose any lies that are keeping them from seeing your goodness and grace (2 Cor. 4:4), and replace those lies with your truth. Remove anything that has hardened their heart and prevented them from understanding who you are (Eph. 4:18).

### Day 3: Romans 5:1

*“Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand.”*

Heavenly Father, I know that trusting in Jesus is the only way to have peace with you and that your grace is what leads us to faith. Please shower \_\_\_\_\_ with your grace, that they may be made right with you and find

peace in a relationship with you. Thank you for enabling me to stand in your grace and peace; as I do, help me be a light that leads \_\_\_\_\_ to you(Matthew 5:14-16).

## **Day 4: Lev. 19:18b & Matt. 22:39**

*“Love your neighbor as yourself.”*

Merciful God, please fill me with your love for \_\_\_\_\_. According to your Word, your kindness is what leads us to repentance (Romans 2:4). Please help me show your kindness to \_\_\_\_\_ in tangible ways that enable them to experience your love. Bring ideas to my mind of how I can reach out to them this week.

## **Day 5: Ephesians 6:19**

*“Pray also for me, that whenever I open my mouth, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the Gospel.”*

Holy Lord, as I interact with \_\_\_\_\_, Lord, please open up opportunities for me to share your Gospel with them. Please give me the words to speak that will help them understand and accept your free gift of salvation. Grant me the courage to speak the truth boldly and the grace to speak in a way that makes them feel loved (Col. 4:2-6).

## **Day 6: 2 Cor. 5:20**

*“We are therefore Christ’s ambassadors, as though God were making His appeal through us. We implore you on Christ’s behalf: Be reconciled to God.”*

King Jesus, I am your ambassador – a representative of you to others on this earth. You have given me the message of reconciliation and the task of sharing that message with others. I pray that you give me the ability to represent you well, and the words to clearly explain your message of reconciliation to the lost. I pray that the next time I see \_\_\_\_\_ you will give me the eyes to see them as you do, the heart to love them the way you do, and words to share with them the message of hope you have for them.
